The Matthews Heritage Trail: Celebrating Historic Crestdale was completed in summer 2021. The trail extends 3 miles, and connects multiple destinations along the way. The trail begins at the rear of Matthews Town Hall / Library, continues through the Historic Crestdale Community and connects to Four Mile Creek Greenway at John Street.

Crestdale is one of the oldest African American communities in North Carolina. The Town of Matthews and the Crestdale community have worked to preserve this piece of local history by completing this trail. Signage is placed at specific locations along the trail, detailing some of the history and interesting facts about Crestdale.
