According to their analysis, Florida is dominating among domestic spring break destinations with five cities landing in the top ten spots.

Orlando, Tampa and Fort Lauderdale were in the top three spots for domestic destinations for family spring breakers.

Among the family spring break spots, Los Angeles had the cheapest average roundtrip airfare at \$278. Orlando, in the top spot, had an average roundtrip airfare of \$337.

Las Vegas, Miami, Los Angeles, Phoenix, Denver and Honolulu were other notable spring break destinations for families. Honolulu had the most expensive average roundtrip airfare at \$751.

"With the rise of international low-cost carriers, traveling to a number of major cities in Europe has become very affordable compared to past years," said Tom Spagnola, SVP of Supplier Relations at CheapOair. "In some cases, taking a family trip to England or France in March – the off-season for those destinations – may end up being cheaper than a trip to one of the tropical destinations."
