Osaka, Japan

Airport & Airline: London Heathrow with British Airways.

Launching: March 31, 2019

With the Rugby World Cup being held in Japan next year, there's never been a more exciting time to visit. While prices will surely go up around September and October during the World Cup, plan a trip to Osaka in May or June when return flights are just £598. If you want to catch the cherry blossoms, the start of April is your best bet.

British Airways will have direct flights to Osaka four times per week on Mondays, Wednesday, Fridays and Sundays from London Heathrow arriving into Kansai International Airport.

Brazil

Launching: Spring 2019

Earlier this year, Norwegian launched its London to Buenos Aires, Argentina, route which has been such a success that the airline is now considering launching a direct London to Brazil route in spring next year. This would be the first-ever low-fare flight route between the UK and Brazil.

Launching: February 2019


Launching: May 15, 2019

Next year, British Airways is launching a thrice-weekly service from London Gatwick to Kos Island International Airport on Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday, starting on May 15 and ending on October 26, 2019. Kos, the most easterly of the Greek Islands, is filled with divine beaches, ancient ruins and towering mountains and, now, is easier than ever to get to.
