Port Wade Glamping Domes – Set within an ideal location out of town, but still close to many attractions and amenities around Annapolis Royal and near the Bay of Fundy region, this 23 foot geodesic glamping dome features a stargazer moonroof and a large panoramic window with a water view across the road. There is an outdoor covered barbecue area, deck with Adirondack chairs and a propane fire table.

Nova Scotia's only 5-star housekeeping, eco-conscious, luxury geodesic dome experience. <u>True North Destinations</u> are located along Cape Breton Island's Cabot Trail coastline offering spectacular ocean views and mountainside lodging. Each of the 10 domes feature private decks, luxurious Queen-sized beds, 3-piece baths, fully equipped kitchenettes, dining/living room area, private hot tubs, BBQ's, privacy pergolas and Wifi.
