





Officiale More than 220 people attended a community meeting last weekend that county civil defense officials held in Ocean View, a neighborhood that lava could reach in hours if molten rock erupts through vents on Mauna Loa's southwest flank.

Bob Werner, an Ocean View resident who didn't attend the meeting, said it's wise to be aware of a possible eruption but not to fear it. He's not concerned that the neighborhood would be completely cut off, if lava flows across the only road connecting it to the bigger towns of Kailua-


